



Hanse Seed Corp.
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A maincrop variety suitable for long term storage. Baby Lou is a firm cooking salad/little potato with yellow skin and yellow flesh. It produces a very high number of tubers (ca. 30-50 tubers/plant) and is very tasty, very pretty and extremely even in size. It is predestined for the little potato market (40 mm) and shows good resistances to PVY-, PVY^{ntn}, bruising, growing cracks, common scab, Rhizoctonia and internal rust spot. Baby Lou has an excellent dormancy.
