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Queen Anne is an early, cooking type B, very homogeneous table variety with a bright skin and a very high marketable yield. Despite maturity class early, it has a good storability. Queen Anne shows very good resistances against PVY, PVY^{ntn}, Rhizoctonia, bruising, common scab, internal rust spots, silver scurf and alternaria. Resistant against Ro 1, 4 and potato wart disease race 1.
